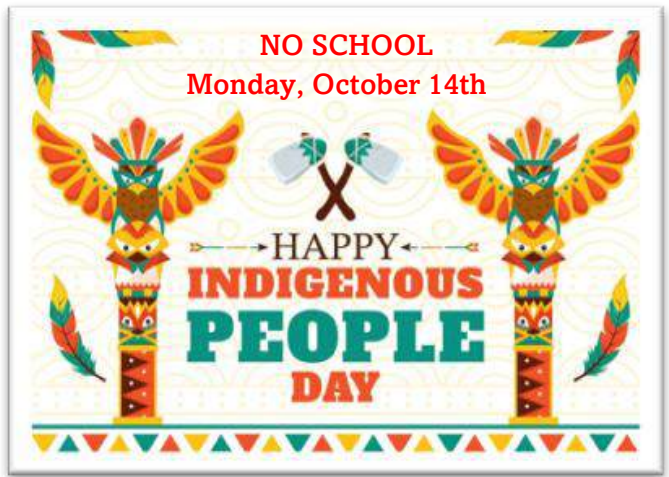

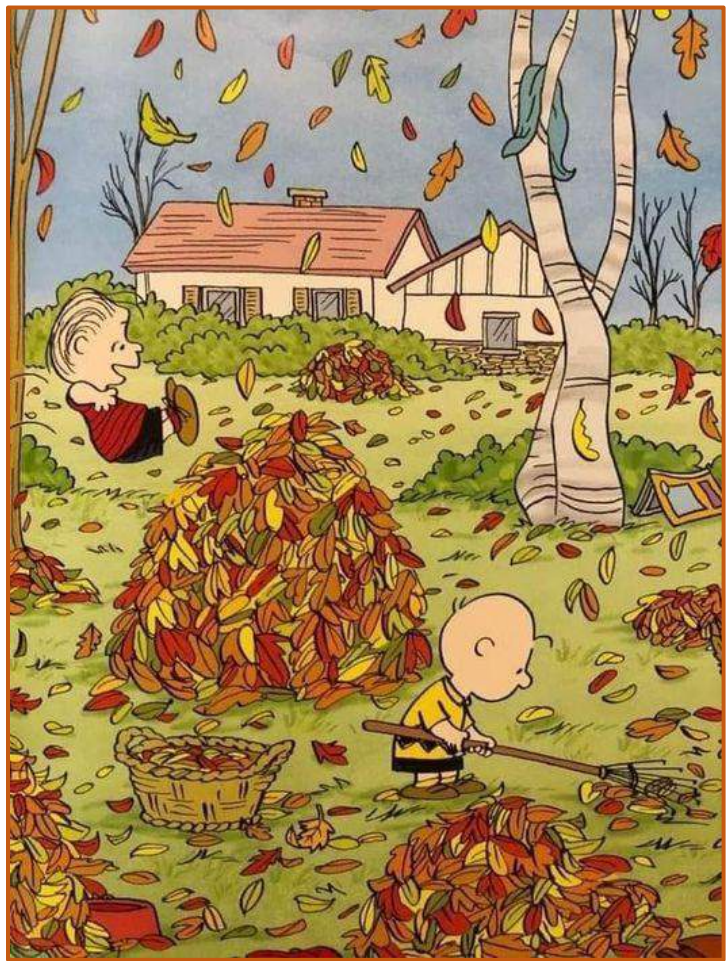
High School is right around the corner.

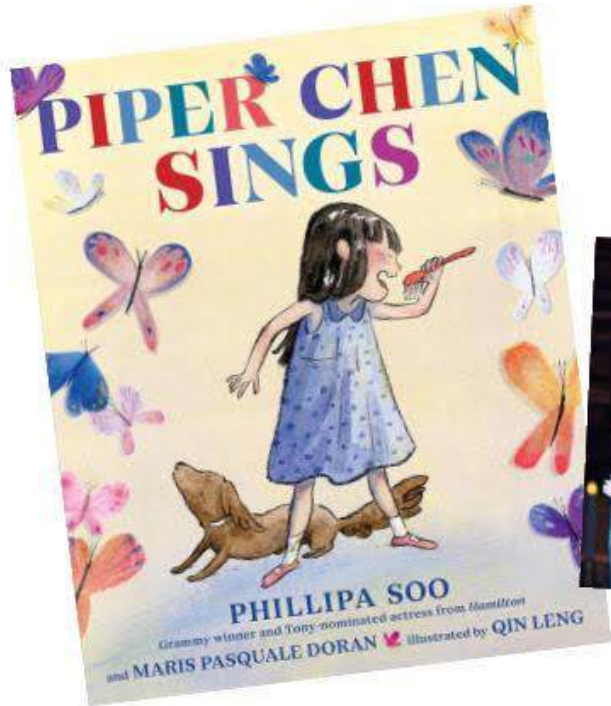

Read for the Record®



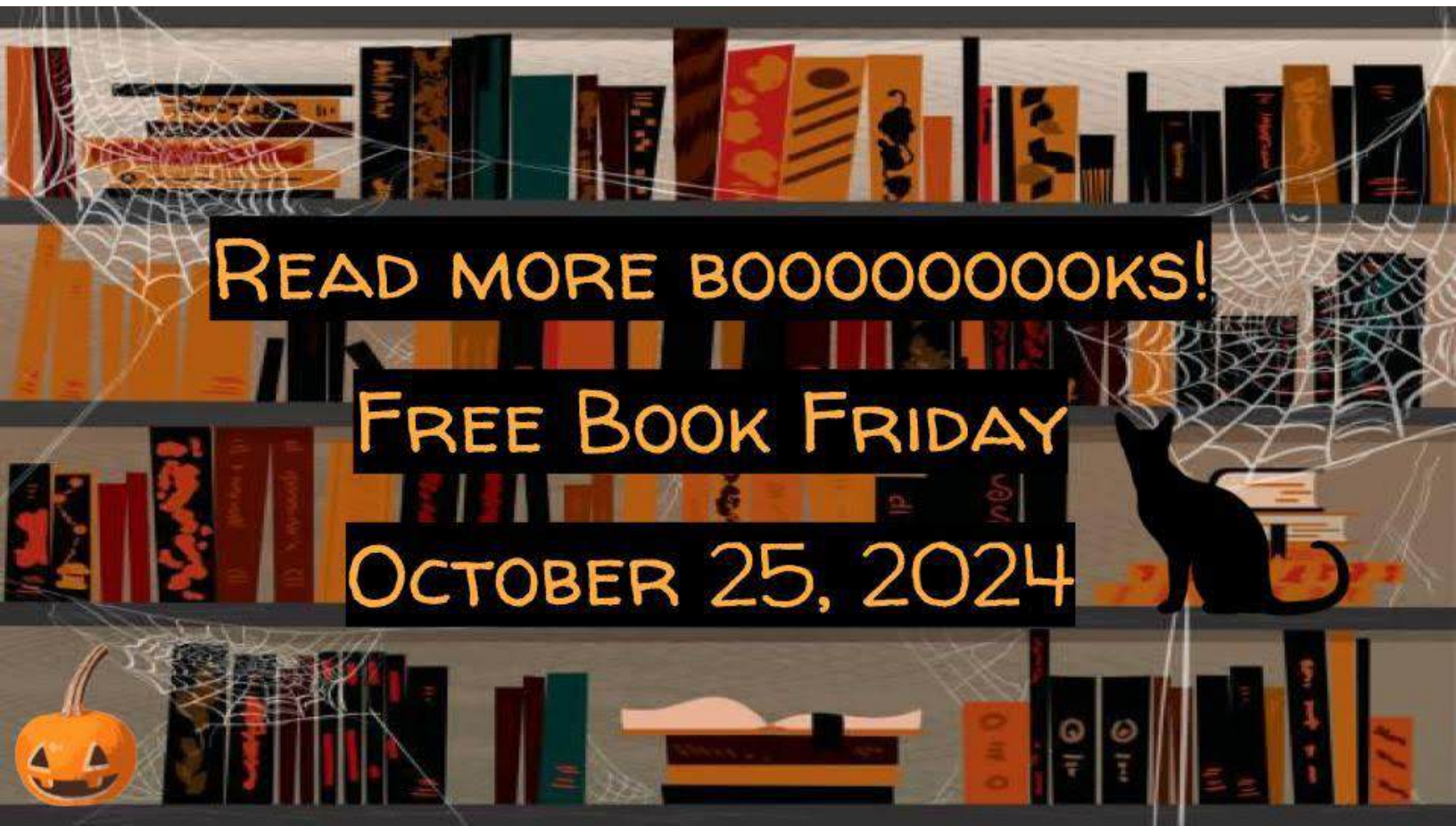
On October 24th, 2024, KCCS will read the same book on the same day as millions of other students and teachers all over the world!
